Day 1-4 | Cape Town and Cape of Good Hope Tour

Day 4-7 | Winelands & De Hoop Nature Reserve Safari



Overnight Spier Hotel | Situated next to the calming Eerste River, Stellenbosch is a picturesque town surrounded by mountains and vineyards and our base for our first wildlife safari at the De Hoop Game Reserve; home to 260 birds and 86 mammals including bontebok, eland, zebra, & antelopes.

Highlights: Stellenbosch, Grande Provence Wine Tasting and Garden Art, AFC Banquet, De Hoop Game Reserve Safari (open 4x4).

Day 7-8 | Durban's Golden Mile, Sharks & Indian Coast



Overnight Protea Hotel Durban Umhlanga | Golden beaches, lush surroundings, and idyllic part of Durban with stunning views overlooking the KwaZulu-Natal coast. You'll enjoy a fascinating exhibit dedicated to sharks and other marine life, where marine biologists and experts explain

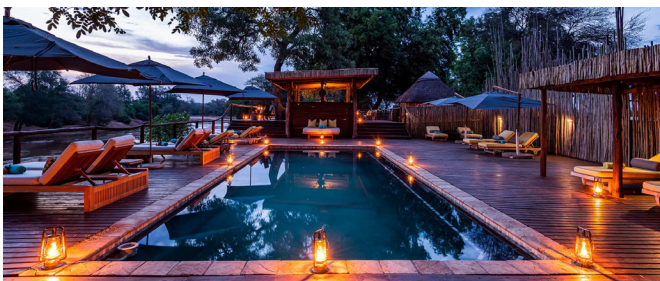
Day 11-14 | Greater Kruger "Big Five" Safari

Highlights: Daily game drives (morning and afternoon), night drives, guided bush walks, luxury accommodation, "Big Five".
